H.O.S.T.S. meets Monday through Thursday during the school year from 8:50 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. at New Palestine Elementary and Tuesday through Friday 11:05 a.m. until 12:20 p.m. at Sugar Creek Elementary.

Mentors work on reading skills with one second-grade student and one third-grade student for 30 minutes each. All materials are provided and no training is necessary.

Mentors choose which day of the week and how often they mentor. Mentors can also choose to be a substitute only.
